### **With my Soul I—Imagine and Reason**

#### **Genesis 6:5**

5 And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. KJV

#### **Genesis 8:21**

21 And the Lord smelled a sweet savour; and the Lord said in his heart, I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more every thing living, as I have done. KJV

#### **Genesis 11:6—Soul Is The Womb of your Faith**

6 And the Lord said, Behold, they are one people and they have all one language; and this is only the beginning of what they will do, and now nothing they have imagined they can do will be impossible for them. AMP

#### **Jeremiah 18:11-12**

11 Now therefore go to, speak to the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, saying, Thus saith the Lord; Behold, I frame evil against you, and

devise a device against you: return ye now every one from his evil way, and make your ways and your doings good.

12 And they said, There is no hope: but we will walk after our own devices, and we will every one do the imagination of his evil heart. KJV

### **Isaiah 1:18**

18 "Come now, and **let us reason (yakach) together**," Says the Lord, "Though your sins are like scarlet, They shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They shall be as wool. NKJV

#### **yakach**

(yaw-kahh'); a primitive root; to be right (i.e. correct); reciprocal, to argue; causatively, to decide, justify or convict: -appoint, argue, chasten, convince, correct (-ion), daysman, dispute, judge, maintain, plead, reason (together), rebuke, reprove (-r), surely, in any wise.

### **1 Kings 18:21—*my soul argues or halts between two opinions***

21 And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long **halt ye between two opinions**? if the Lord be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word. KJV

### **Isaiah 1:2-4**

2 Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth! For the Lord has spoken: "I have nourished and brought up children, And they have rebelled against Me;

3 The ox knows its owner And the donkey its master's crib; But Israel does not know, My people do not **consider**."

4 Alas, sinful nation, A people laden with iniquity, A brood of evildoers, Children who are **corrupters**! They have forsaken the Lord, They have provoked to anger The Holy One of Israel, They have turned away backward. NKJV

### **Isaiah 1:5**

5 Why should you be stricken again? You will revolt more and more. The **whole head is sick**, And the **whole heart faints**. NKJV

### **Isaiah 1:11-14**

11 "To what purpose is the multitude of your sacrifices to Me?" Says the Lord. "I have had enough of burnt offerings of rams And the fat of fed cattle. I do not delight in the blood of bulls, Or of lambs or goats.

12 "When you come to appear before Me, Who has required this from your hand, To trample My courts?

13 Bring no more futile sacrifices; Incense is an abomination to Me. The New Moons, the Sabbaths, and the calling of assemblies — I cannot endure iniquity and the sacred meeting.

14 Your New Moons and your appointed feasts **My soul hates**; They are a trouble to Me, I am weary of bearing them. NKJV

### **Isaiah 1:15-20**

15 When you spread out your hands, I will hide My eyes from you; Even though you make many prayers, I will not hear. Your hands are full of blood.

16 "Wash yourselves, make yourselves clean; Put away the evil of your doings from before My eyes. Cease to do evil,

17 Learn to do good; Seek justice, Rebuke the oppressor; Defend the fatherless, Plead for the widow.

18 "Come now, and **let us reason together**," Says the Lord, "Though your sins are like scarlet, They shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They shall be as wool.

19 If you are willing and obedient, You shall eat the good of the land;

20 But if you refuse and rebel, You shall be devoured by the sword"; For the mouth of the Lord has spoken. NKJV

### **Romans 8:5-9**

5 Those who live according to the sinful nature have their **minds set on what that nature desires**; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their **minds set on what the Spirit** desires.

6 The mind of sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace;

7 the sinful mind is hostile to God. It does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so.

8 Those controlled by the sinful nature cannot please God.

9 You, however, are controlled not by the sinful nature but by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Christ. NIV

### **Romans 8:10-17**

10 And Christ lives within you, so even though your body will die because of sin, the Spirit gives you life because you have been made right with God.

11 The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you. And just as God raised Christ Jesus from the dead, he will give life to your mortal bodies by this same Spirit living within you.

12 Therefore, dear brothers and sisters, you have **no obligation to do what your sinful nature (flesh) urges you to do.**

13 For if you live by **its dictates**, you will die. But if through the power of the Spirit you put to death the deeds of your sinful nature, you will live.

14 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God.

15 So you have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God's Spirit when he adopted you as his own children. Now we call him, "Abba, Father."

16 For his Spirit joins with our spirit to affirm that we are God's children.

17 And since we are his children, we are his heirs. In fact, together with Christ we are heirs of God's glory. But if we are to share his glory, we must also share his suffering. NLT

**Spirit—Law of the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus—Romans 8:2**

**Soul—Law of my Mind—Reason Romans 7:23**

**Body—Law of Sin and Death—Romans 8:2**

**Romans 8:2**

2 For the **law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus** hath made me free from the **law of sin and death.** KJV

**Romans 7:23-25**

23 but I see **another law** at work in the members of my body, waging war against **the law of my mind** and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within my members.

24 What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death?

25 Thanks be to God — through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself in my mind am a slave to God's law, but in the sinful nature a slave to the law of sin. NIV

**My Mind is the Deciding Vote Between my Spirit and My Flesh**

**Romans 12:2**

2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. NKJV

2 Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect. NLT
